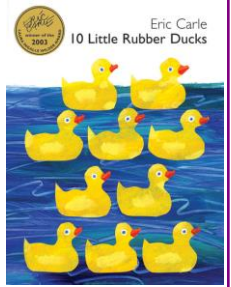


Eric Carle is a fun author to read. A couple of his books relating to our math concepts are:

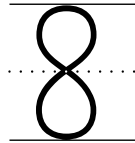
